# COVID-19 vaccination accommodations for autistic people

Victorian Disability Liaison Officers (DLOs) can provide assistance to people with disability to access COVID-19 vaccinations at vaccination centers.

To enable DLOs to support you, you can discuss specific accommodations that can help make the vaccination process easier for you.

Below is a list of accommodations that might be helpful for autistic people to get vaccinated. You can discuss these accommodations when you contact a DLO for support to get vaccinated.

A DLO will be able to provide advice on which vaccination site will be most suitable for your needs and will help you make a booking.

#### Accommodations you may want to inquire about:

- A private space to be vaccinated in.
- Bringing a support person with you for all stages of the vaccination process.
- Attending a low sensory clinic.
- Attending the clinic at a quieter time
- Avoiding the queue and wait times before being vaccinated.
- Seating whilst queuing.
- A Virtual Reality (VR) headset to wear during your vaccination to help with needle fears (available at Frankston hubs, Royal Exhibition Building, Sandown Racecourse and Clayton hospital).
- A group booking.
- A longer appointment.
- Lowered lighting.
- Bringing something to distract you whilst you get vaccinated.
- A quiet space to wait in after your vaccination.

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• For people who are unable to attend a vaccination clinic in person, it may be possible for DLOs to support an in-home vaccination appointment. If this is an accommodation that will help you get vaccinated, you should discuss it with the DLO.
